- **Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:** Draft Commission Regulation amending Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the use of certain UV filters in cosmetic products (4 page(s), in English; 3 page(s), in English)
- **Description of content:** The draft Commission Regulation aims at amending the existing restrictions for Benzophenone-3 and Octocrylene, taking into account the latest opinions by the Scientific Committee on Consumer Safety (SCCS) of 30-31 March 2021 on these two UV filters. In particular, lowering the current maximum concentrations for Benzophenone-3 of 6% to 2.2% when used in body products, including propellant and pump spray products, and for Octocrylene of 10% to 9% when used in propellant spray products.
- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Protection of human health or safety

**Proposed date of entry into force:** 20 days from publication in the Official Journal of the EU ('The provisions shall apply from': Cosmetic products containing these UV filters and complying with the restrictions set out in Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 as applicable on [the day before the date of entry into force of this Regulation] may be placed on the Union market until [6 months after the date of entry into force of this Regulation] and be made available on the Union market until [12 months after the date of entry into force of this Regulation]).
